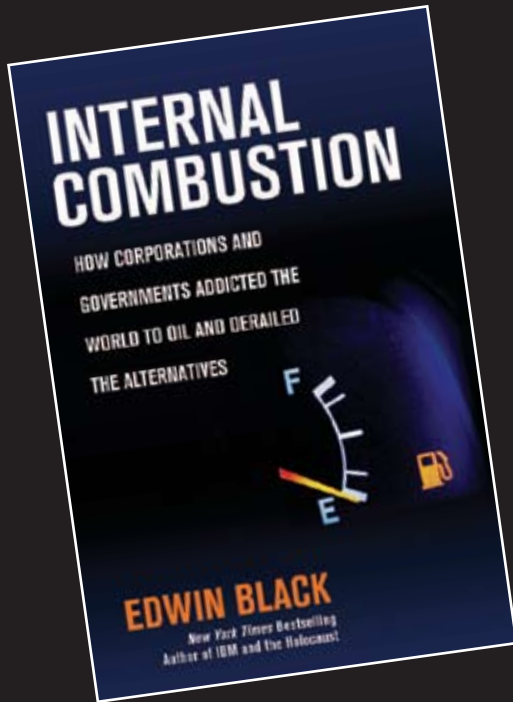


Join us for the world book-launch of
